



FIA ANTI-DOPING DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

Mr Sacha BOTTEMANNE – Decision notified on 20.07.2016

Mr Sacha BOTTEMANNE (FRA), who participated in Magny-Cours (France) competition of the Championnat de France FFSA GT 2015 and who was selected for a doping control on 30 August 2015, refused to submit to sample collection.

The FIA Anti-Doping Disciplinary Committee (ADC) held a hearing on this case in Paris on 6 June 2016.

Decision of the ADC

The ADC has concluded that the Athlete committed an infringement of the 2016 FIA Anti-Doping Regulations, and in particular of Article 2.3 thereof, by refusing to submit to sample collection within the context of a doping control.

As a consequence, the ADC has decided to impose the following sanctions on Mr Sacha BOTTEMANNE:

1. A disqualification of all competitive results possibly obtained by Mr Sacha BOTTEMANNE as from 30 August 2015, with all of the resulting consequences including forfeiture of any trophies, points and prizes;
2. A sanction of ineligibility for a period of 2 (two) years, starting on 6 June 2016 and expiring on 6 June 2018.
3. A fine of 5,000 Euros. Should the Athlete fail to pay this sum within one month of the notification of the decision, the aforementioned period of ineligibility will be extended by one year.

Mr Sacha BOTTEMANNE, as well as the other persons listed under Article 13.2.3 of the 2016 FIA Anti-Doping Regulations, can appeal this decision to the Court of Arbitration for Sport.
