



FIA ANTI-DOPING DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

Mr Michalis DAFNOMILIS – Decision notified on 23.11.2016

Mr Michalis DAFNOMILIS (GRC), who participated as a co-Driver in the International FIA Hi-Tech Eco Mobility Rally 2015, on 4 October 2015 in Athens, Greece, and who was selected for a doping control on 4 October 2015, tested positive for chlortalidone (listed under category S5 "Diuretics and Masking Agents" of the WADA 2015 Prohibited List).

The FIA Anti-Doping Disciplinary Committee (ADC) held a closed hearing on this case via telephone conference on 16 November 2016.

Decision of the ADC

The ADC has concluded that an Anti-Doping Rule Violation according to Article 2.1 of the 2015 FIA Anti-Doping Regulations – "Presence of Prohibited Substance or its Metabolites or Markers in an Athlete's Sample" – has been established.

As a consequence, the ADC has decided to impose the following sanctions on Mr Michalis DAFNOMILIS:

1. A disqualification of all competitive results possibly obtained by Mr Michalis DAFNOMILIS as from 4 October 2015, with all of the resulting consequences including forfeiture of any trophies, points and prizes;
2. A sanction of ineligibility for a period of 2 (two) years, starting on 4 October 2015 and expiring on 4 October 2017.
