### **DECISION OF THE INTERNATIONAL COURT OF APPEAL**

The International Court of Appeal met in Paris on Tuesday, September 21, 2004, in order to examine the appeal introduced by the Automobile Club d'Italia/Commissione Sportiva Automobilistica Italiana on behalf of licence-holder GPC Sport srl, car N°62: Christian Pescatori/Iraj Alexander, against decision N.GT 013 made by the Panel of the Stewards on September 5, 2004, concerning the exclusion of car N°62 during the event run at Imola (Italy) on September 5, 2004, and counting towards the 2004 FIA GT Championship.

Having heard the explanations of both parties and having examined the various documents and other evidence, the Court upheld the decision of the Panel of the Stewards.

The International Court of Appeal was presided over by Mr Xavier Conesa (Spain), and composed of Mr Harry Duijm (Netherlands), Mr Vassilis Koussis (Greece), and Mr Reginald Redmond (Ireland).
