Fact Car 55 did not appear to slow under yellow flags into turn 5.

Offence Alleged Breach of Appendix H, Article 2.4.5.1 (b) of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision No further action.

Reason A comparison of telemetry of the lap concerned (his 26th lap) with the previous lap initially indicated that the driver braked late under the yellow flags. However, the driver explained that the previous lap had been abnormal. A comparison against his 14th lap clearly indicated that he had braked earlier under the yellow flags and had slowed through that section compared to the faster lap.
