Mr Ladislav HANÁK

Decision notified on 10.12.2012

Mr Ladislav Hanák, who took part in the Nyirad (HUN) event counting towards the 2012 FIA European Championship for Autocross Drivers and who was selected for a doping control on 18 August 2012, tested positive for Metoprolol (specified substance), a beta-blocker registered under point P2 of the 2012 WADA Prohibited List.

The FIA Anti-Doping Disciplinary Committee (ADC) held a hearing on this case in Paris on 29 October 2012.

Decision of the ADC

The ADC concluded that an Anti-Doping Rule Violation according to Article 2.1 of the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations – "Presence of a Prohibited Substance or its Metabolites or Markers in a Driver's Sample" – was established.

As a consequence, the ADC has decided to impose the following sanctions on Mr Ladislav Hanák:

- 1) A Sanction of Reprimand;
- 2) Disqualification of the result obtained by the Athlete in the Nyirad (HUN) event of the 2012 FIA European Championship for Autocross Drivers, with all of the resulting consequences including forfeiture of any trophies, points and prizes.

Mr Ladislav Hanák has 21 days in which to appeal this decision to the Court of Arbitration for Sport.
