

FIA ANTI-DOPING DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

Mr Piotr Feliks BEAUPRÉ – Decision notified on 18.12.2013

Mr Piotr Feliks BEAUPRÉ (POL), who participated in the Baja Poland event of the FIA World Cup for Cross-Country Rallies, on 01 September 2013, tested positive to Chlorothiazide and Hydrochlorothiazide, both diuretics, as specified under point S5 of the 2013 World Anti-Doping Agency Prohibited List.

The FIA Anti-Doping Disciplinary Committee (ADC) held a hearing in this case by telephone on 6 November 2013.

Decision of the ADC

The ADC has concluded that an Anti-Doping Rule Violation according to Article 2.1 of the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations – "Presence of Prohibited Substance or its Metabolites or Markers in a driver's Sample" – has been established.

As a consequence, the ADC has decided to impose the following sanctions on Mr Piotr Feliks BEAUPRÉ:

- 1. A sanction of reprimand;
- 2. A disqualification of the competitive results obtained by Mr Piotr Feliks BEAUPRÉ during the event, with all of the resulting consequences including forfeiture of any trophies, points and prizes.

Mr Piotr Feliks BEAUPRÉ has 21 days in which to appeal this decision to the Court of Arbitration for Sport.
