FIA ANTI-DOPING DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

Mr Johan KRISTOFFERSEN – Decision notified on 11.11.2014

Mr Johan KRISTOFFERSEN (SWE), who participated in the Mettet (Belgium) competition of the FIA World Rallycross Championship and who was selected for a doping control on 13 July 2014, tested positive for Prednisolone and its metabolite Prednisone (Glucocorticosteroids registered under point S9 of the 2014 WADA Prohibited List).

The FIA Anti-Doping Disciplinary Committee (ADC) held a hearing in this case in Paris on 1st October 2014.

Decision of the ADC

The ADC has concluded that an Anti-Doping Rule Violation according to Article 2.1 of the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations – "Presence of Prohibited Substance or its Metabolites or Markers in a driver's Sample" – has been established.

As a consequence, the ADC has decided to impose the following sanctions on Mr Johan KRISTOFFERSEN:

- 1. the sanction of reprimand;
- 2. a disqualification of the competitive results obtained by Mr Johan KRISTOFFERSEN during the Mettet competition of the FIA World Rallycross Championship, with all of the resulting consequences including forfeiture of any trophies, points and prizes.

Mr Johan KIRSTOFFERSEN has 21 days in which to appeal this decision to the Court of Arbitration for Sport.
