Award of the Court of Arbitration for Sport

Reminder of the facts:

Mr Marc Amez-Droz tested positive for Hydrochlorothiazide, a diuretic registered under point S5 of the 2014 World Anti-Doping Agency Prohibited List, during the Brands Hatch (GBR) event counting towards the FIA Lurani Trophy for Formula Junior Cars on 25 May 2014.

By a decision dated 12 August 2014, the FIA Anti-doping Disciplinary Committee disqualified Mr Marc Amez-Droz from the competitive result achieved in the Brands Hatch (GBR) event of the 2014 FIA Lurani Trophy for Formula Junior Cars, as well as from any competitive results achieved as from 25 May 2014, with all of the resulting consequences including forfeiture of any trophies, points and prizes, and suspended him for 2 (two) years, starting on 25 May 2014 and expiring on 25 May 2016.

Mr Marc Amez-Droz exercised his right to appeal this decision to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS), based in Lausanne, Switzerland.

CAS Award:

By an award dated 28 January 2015, the Panel of the CAS decided to dismiss the appeal filled by Mr Marc Amez-Droz and to confirm the sanction of two years of ineligibility decided by the FIA Anti-doping Disciplinary Committee against Mr Marc Amez-Droz.
