Clarification Note N°11 – to all FIA F3 European Championship Competitors

Dear Competitors,

Please find bellow clarifications regarding the Sporting Regulations

Article 24.8 - Scrutineering and sporting checks:

“Teams must ensure that all chassis and engine data from each qualifying session or race is available, directly from the car, at any time after a session or race and until the cars are released from post-qualifying or post-race parc fermé. Teams are reminded that it is their responsibility to satisfy the scrutineers, and if necessary the stewards, that their cars are in compliance with the regulations at all times during an Event.”

Article 29.4 - Engines :

“With respect to Article 29.4 of the 2014 Formula 3 European Championship Sporting Regulations, and with the exception of the engine block, cylinder head, sump or cam cover, the FIA will accept mileage alone as evidence of physical wear or damage to parts during an engine inspection”.
