Re: Braking zones for the 6 HOURS OF SHANGHAI

Decision

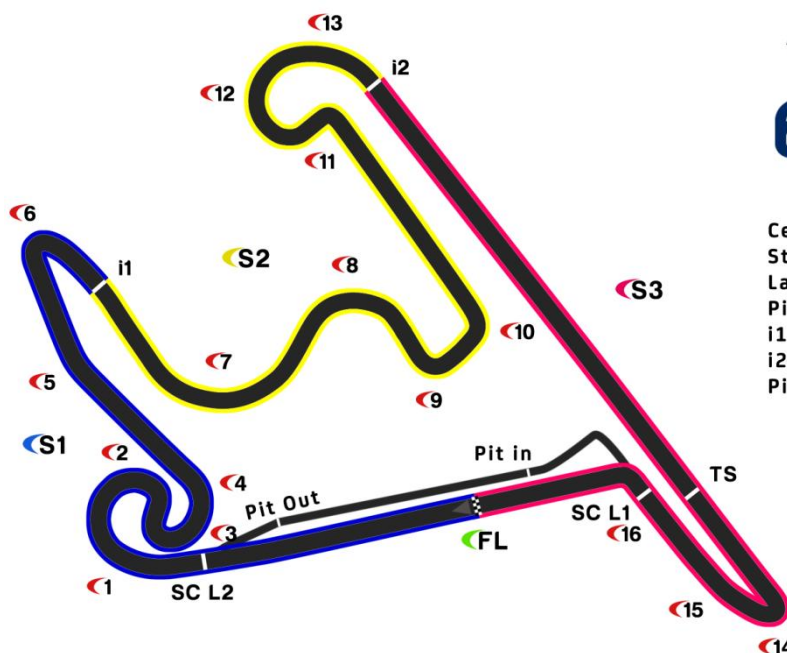
In the view to achieve a proper control of energy released by Hybrid cars between "brakings", a clarification of the definition of "braking" (art 1.13 of technical rules) will be applied by predetermination of braking zones on the circuit.

Simulation have conducted to predetermination of the following braking zones for the 6 HOURS OF SHANGHAI (4 "braking zones") :

- Braking zone #1 : Turn # 1
- Braking zone #2 : Turn # 6
- Braking zone #3 : Turn # 11
- Braking zone #4 : Turn # 14

The entry of each zone will be considered at the 50m board before the curve.

Centerline: 5.451 m.
Start Line Offset: 190,5 m.
Lap by Pits: 5.514 m.
Pit In - Pit Out: 384,4 m.
i1 at: 1.732,5 m.
i2 at: 3.563,8 m.
Pit in at: 5.512 m.
