#### Decision

As indicated on the Endurance Committee decision 14-D0011-LMP1, we made new tests to check for possible variation of flow with higher fuel temperature.

These tests were carried out with a fuel temperature of 29C°.

Considering that:

- It is possible to observe such temperature for some of the next 5 races
- It is not felt suitable to enter in an over complicated and ridiculous process consisting to adjust the restrictor for each 1C° variation,

The diameter "D" of the flow restrictor described in Appendix A of 2014 LMP1 Technical Regulations will be adapted according to the tests made with a fuel temperature of 29C° as follows:

- Diesel fuel 25mm for all races until the end of the season,
- Petrol fuel : 25,95 mm maximum for all races until the end of the season,

However, if on the scrutineering day, weather forecasts predict an ambient temperature during the race less than 21C°, it will be mandatory to use the restrictor defined for Silverstone & Spa in the Endurance Committee decision 14-D0011-LMP1.

Fuel temperature measurements will be made during these 5 events to anticipate an average temperature for the 2015 season.
