WELCOME TO CIRCUIT DE CATALUNYA

Circuit de Catalunya will be host to the Formula 1® World Championship from 10 to 12 May. This edition of the FORMULA 1 GRAN PREMIO DE ESPAÑA 2013 will be the 23rd consecutive Grand Prix held at the Circuit facilities since their inauguration in 1991. Of the 19 circuits which make up the calendar of the 2013 season, Circuit de Catalunya is the only racetrack located in Spain and the only racetrack to hold not only a Grand Prix, but also preseason tests. For another year, the Circuit de Catalunya track will offer the chance to see the first evolutions of the single-seaters in the season, as the Catalan track will be once again venue of the first race in Europe after the events in Australia, Malaysia, China and Bahrain.

Along these 23 years of Grands Prix, thirteen different drivers have passed into history as winners of the Spanish Grand Prix at Circuit de Catalunya. Most part of these drivers have been World Champions, to be precise, ten; and there has been a different winner every year since 2006: Nigel Mansell (1991, 1992), Alain Prost (1993), Damon Hill (1994), Michael Schumacher (1995, 1996, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004), Jacques Villeneuve (1997), Mika Häkkinen (1998, 1999, 2000), Kimi Räikkönen (2005, 2008), Fernando Alonso (2006), Felipe Massa (2007), Jenson Button (2009), Mark Webber (2010), Sebastian Vettel (2011) and Pastor Maldonado (2012).

From the sporting perspective, the World Championship could not be more exciting on its arrival at Circuit de Catalunya. With three different winners in the four Grands Prix that have already been staged, Sebastian Vettel leads the standings, followed by Kimi Räikkönen, 10 points behind, Lewis Hamilton, 27 points behind, and Fernando Alonso, 30 points behind. The Formula 1® World Championship is open and with a large number of drivers having a chance to win and to get onto the podium. Moreover, it will be interesting to see the 2013 grid at Circuit de Catalunya, considering that it has changed a lot since last season, with Lewis Hamilton in Mercedes, Sergio Pérez in McLaren, Nico Hulkenberg in Sauber, Charles Pic in Caterham and the return of Adrian Sutil to Force India, in addition to the recently arrived Esteban Gutiérrez in Sauber, Valtteri Bottas in Williams, Giedo van der Garde in Caterham and Jules Bianchi and Max Chilton in Marussia. An additional attraction for local fans will be the test drivers at Scuderia Ferrari, the Catalans Pedro de la Rosa and Marc Gené, who are working together for the first time with Fernando Alonso in the year in which he will be trying to equal the 3 World Championship titles achieved by Sebastian Vettel.

In addition to the FORMULA 1 GRAN PREMIO DE ESPAÑA 2013, there will be three other championships contested during the weekend. The GP2 series will arrive at Circuit de Catalunya to

stage the third event of the season after the first races in Malaysia and Bahrain, and the GP3 Series and the Porsche Mobil 1 Supercup will stage their season opening rounds in Spain.

A track with all of the advantages

Circuit de Catalunya offers fans benchmark facilities to make the experience of living the FORMULA 1 GRAN PREMIO DE ESPAÑA 2013 unforgettable. All those fans who purchased their tickets in advance were able to benefit from 20% or 10% off the ticket price depending on the presale period, the last of which ended on 1 March. There were 13 grandstands to choose from, two of them offering one-day tickets (C and E), and general admittance areas, with a direct view of 15 giant screens distributed along the spectator areas of Circuit de Catalunya. The tickets, as well as the Circuit Member tickets and Hospitality passes offer different advantages to enjoy the city of Barcelona and the surroundings during the Grand Prix, such as the free admittance to the Barcelona Motor Show, and special discounts for the Camp Nou Experience, La Roca Village and the Barcelona Bus Touristic.

All fans with a Grand Prix ticket, Circuit Members and Officials will be able to enjoy Formula 1® from Thursday, with the traditional pit-lane walkabout and the chance to get an autograph from the drivers on that same day in the afternoon. Moreover, Circuit Members and Officials will be able to make a tour around the paddock of the support races on Saturday afternoon. On Sunday, there will be again the chance to watch the drivers during the track parade before the Grand Prix, on beautiful classic vehicles, in addition to the new podium format with post-race interviews of the top three carried out in front of the fans.

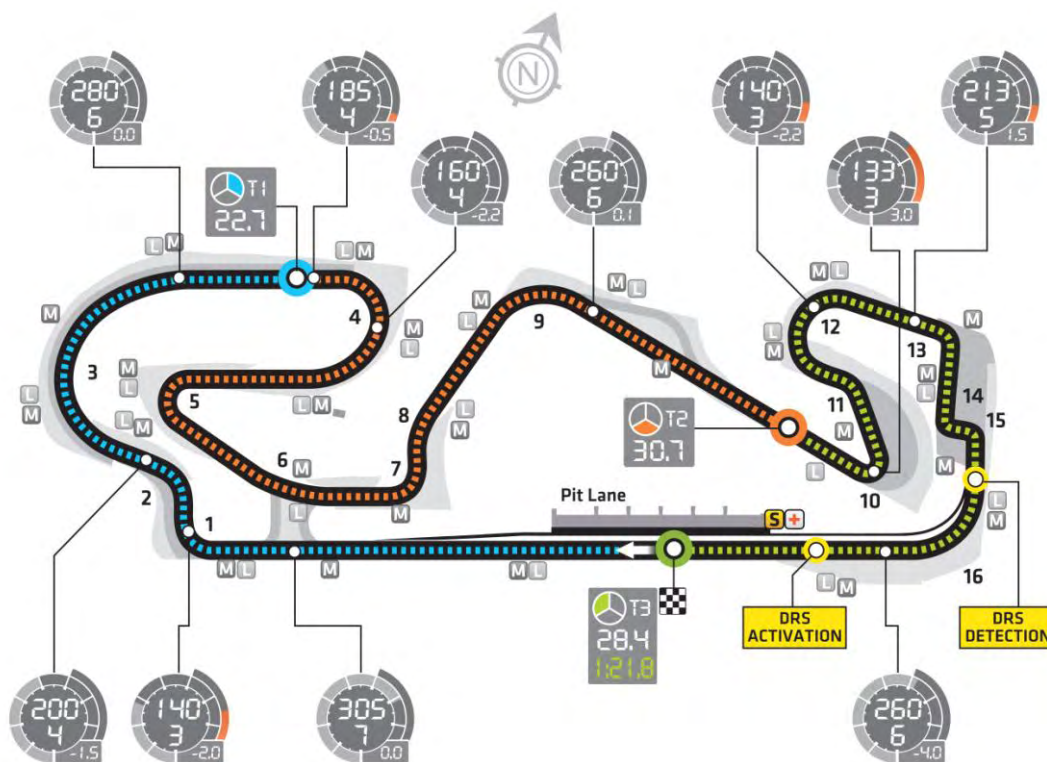

Recommendations for helping to make the organisational side a success

The finest organisational work on the sports side must go hand in hand with a suitable welcome for the enthusiasts, from the time they spend on the road to when they take up positions at the Circuit, and good arrangements for the media and clients of the various hospitality areas. Getting everyone into and out of last year's F1® Grand Prix was handled very successfully. This year Circuit will be ready again to take on the challenge of achieving maximum fluidity in the access points. The basic recommendations are these:

Use public transport

In addition to studying various options with Catalonia's police force (Mossos d'Esquadra) for getting to and leaving the Circuit in such a way as to keep traffic problems down to a minimum, the Circuit will be continuing to offer options for getting to Montmeló by public transport:

- The **Sagalés coach company** will be making it possible to get to the GP by coach from Barcelona. The coaches will leave from Barcelona city centre, at the crossroads between Passeig de Sant Joan and Carrer Diputació, and will arrive at the Eastern Area of the Circuit. Tickets cost 9 euros, and reservations can be made from the Sagalés company (www.sagales.com - tel. 902 13 00 14).

-The **Spanish railway company Renfe** will be reinforcing its line-2 regional-train service from Barcelona by putting extra places to facilitate getting to the F1® Grand Prix. Renfe will be putting on special trains linking Barcelona and Montmeló. Once at Montmeló, there are three ways of getting to Circuit de Catalunya: using a special shuttle service, by taxi or going on foot, which takes about 20 minutes.

Taking advantage of the areas set aside for private vehicles

Recommended exits from the AP7 motorway and the C17 main road are shown for getting to the Media Car Park, as well as for getting to the other car parks at the surroundings of the Circuit.

Follow instructions from the police and the organisation staff

Take note of the information posters put up outside and inside the Circuit. For security reasons, no cans, bottles, fireworks or any other potentially dangerous objects may be brought into the Circuit.

Photobus service for photographers around the service track

A photobus service will be available to ease the photographers' transfers around the service track. The starting point is next to the Control Tower and the timetable will be as follows:

Practice sessions	First departure 60' before the start of the session.
Qualifying session	Last departure 40' before the start of the session. Pick up 5'/10' after the chequered flag (several trips over at least half an hour)
Race	First departure 90' before the starting time of the race. Last departure 75' before the start of the race

Other services in the Press Room:

- Catering service will be offered to all the media representatives in the Press Room.
- Free of charge camera repair service will be available in the Press Room for all the photographers accredited.

It must be outlined that all radio and/or television broadcasts from the Press Room are prohibited, unless specific authorisation has been obtained from the FIA F1 Head of Communications.

Photographers with 'One event' passes may only enter the Press Conference Room in order to take photographs of official press conferences held throughout the event. They will be allowed into the Press Conference Room 15 minutes before the press conference starts and must leave as soon as it has finished.

ADDITIONAL MEDIA OPPORTUNITIES

- **Qualifying:** All drivers eliminated in Q1 or Q2 will be available for media interviews immediately after the end of each session, as will drivers who participated in Q3, but who are not required for the post-qualifying press conference, at the back of the FIA garage, paddock side.
- **Race:** Any driver retiring before the end of the race will be available for media interviews after his return to the paddock. In addition, all drivers who finish the race outside the top three will be available for media interviews immediately after the end of the race, at each team's individual garage/hospitality or at the back of the FIA garage.
- During the race every team will make at least one senior spokesperson available for interviews by officially accredited TV crews. A list of those nominated will be available in the media centre.
