All the above cars were found to be in conformity with the safety requirements of the 2013 FIA Formula One Technical Regulations.

A seal was broken on the gearbox of car number 18, driver Jean-Eric Vergne, in order to inspect the gear ratios and associated dog rings for physical damage.

This was done in accordance with Article 28.6d of the 2013 Formula One Sporting Regulations.

A seal was broken on the gearbox of car number 22, driver Jules Bianchi, in order to inspect the 6^{th} and 7^{th} gear ratios and associated dog rings for physical damage.

This was done in accordance with Article 28.6d of the 2013 Formula One Sporting Regulations.

The cockpit exit time according to Article 13.1 of the 2013 FIA Formula One Technical Regulations and the clearance of the driver's knees according to Article 13.3 of the 2013 FIA Formula One Technical Regulations have been successfully checked with the driver James Calado.
