Facts Car 21 and car 22 collided on the approach to Turn 1

Offence Alleged Breach of 16.1 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations

Decision No further action

Reason

The incident was the result of actions by the drivers of car 21 (Giedo van der Garde) and car 23 (Max Chilton) which contributed to car 21 impacting the rear right of car 22 (Jules Bianchi). The Stewards do not believe either the driver of car 21 or car 22 were wholly or predominately to blame for the incident.
