Fact The right rear wheel came off at Turn 1 after the car was released from its pit stop.

Offence Breach of Article 23.12 (b) of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations and Article

14.7 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations and Technical Directive TD/017-13.

Decision A drop of 10 grid positions

The competitor (Scuderia Toro Rosso) is also fined €30,000.

Reason This is regarded as a serious offence and the Stewards are of the opinion that this

was a significant breach of the safety requirements. The Stewards request the FIA Technical Delegate to satisfy himself as to the compliance of the two Toro Rosso cars

with Article 14.7 of the FIA Formula One Technical Regulations and Technical

Directive TD/017-13 prior to their further participation in the Event.

The FIA Technical Delegate is also requested to examine all other cars in the Event to

confirm compliance with Article 14.7 and TD/017-13.
