The Stewards, having received a report from the Technical Delegate (Document 14), heard from a team representative, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

No / Driver 25 - Jean-Eric Vergne

Competitor Scuderia Toro Rosso

Session Practice 1

Fact Car 25 used prime specification tyres allocated for use in the first 30 minutes of P1 after 10:30.

Offence Breach of Article 25.4 a) of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

Decision The competitor (Scuderia Toro Rosso) is fined €10,000.

The penalty is suspended for the rest of the season unless the competitor commits a similar infringement in which case this penalty shall become payable immediately without prejudice to any other penalty imposed for the further infringement.

Reason The competitor admitted the infringement and sought to mitigate. Having considered the facts the Stewards accept that the infringement was inadvertent and no advantage was gained as a result. In the circumstances, the Stewards decided that a suspended penalty was appropriate for the infringement.
