The Stewards, having received a report from the Technical Delegate (Document 14), heard from a team representative, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

**No / Driver** 25 - Jean-Eric Vergne

**Competitor** Scuderia Toro Rosso

**Time** 10:30

**Session** Practice 1

**Fact** Car 25 used prime specification tyres allocated for use in the first 30 minutes of P1 after 10:30.

**Offence** Breach of Article 25.4 a) of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

**Decision** The competitor (Scuderia Toro Rosso) is fined €10,000.

The penalty is suspended for the rest of the season unless the competitor commits a similar infringement in which case this penalty shall become payable immediately without prejudice to any other penalty imposed for the further infringement.

**Reason** The competitor admitted the infringement and sought to mitigate. Having considered the facts the Stewards accept that the infringement was inadvertent and no advantage was gained as a result. In the circumstances, the Stewards decided that a suspended penalty was appropriate for the infringement.
