All the above cars were found to be in conformity with the safety requirements of the 2014 FIA Formula One Technical Regulations.

A seal was broken on the gearbox of car number 99, driver Adrian Sutil, in order to inspect the gear ratios and associated dog rings for physical damage and as a result of this inspection to replace 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 6th and 7th gear ratio pair and 1/3, 2/4 and 6/8 gear dog rings.

This was done in accordance with Article 28.6d of the 2014 Formula One Sporting Regulations.

A seal was broken on the gearbox of car number 25, driver Jean-Eric Vergne, in order to inspect the gear ratios and associated dog rings for physical damage and as a result of this inspection to replace 1/3 and 2/4 gear dog rings.

This was done in accordance with Article 28.6d of the 2014 Formula One Sporting Regulations.
