REGULATIONS

Article 4 – Insurances

In compliance with the legal prescriptions, the Organiser has contracted one or several insurance(s) guaranteeing the following risk(s): the FPAK (ASN) affects a Master Insurance Policy in respect of third Party Civil Liability with a value of 40.000.000.00€ per occurrence for bodily injury and 8.000.000.00€ per occurrence for material damages.

Article 5 – Protests and Appeals

Amount of the protest fee: €1,000.

Amount of the appeal fee set by the ASN: €1,000.

Amount of the international appeal fee (FIA): €6,000.

All protests will be lodged in accordance with the Code (Articles 172, 173 and 174) All protests must be made in writing and handed to the clerk of the course or his assistant, or in their absence any of the stewards of the event, together with the required protest fee.

If the protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of a car, the claimant must make a deposit of €2,000.

Competitors have the right to appeal, as laid down in Articles 181, 182 and 183 of the Code and also as set out in the Rules of the International Court of Appeal.
