



## FIA ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

We need to be part of the solution to solving the climate crisis and accelerating the transition towards a sustainable future for all. Considering our role in promoting safe, sustainable and accessible motor sport and mobility, the Fédération Internationale de l'Automobile commits to reduce the environmental impact of the organisation and to encourage sustainability and environmental awareness within the FIA, among its governing bodies, its members, and other interested parties.

The FIA environmental policy applies to all operational activities, at all FIA locations (Paris, Geneva and Valleiry) and to all events we organise.

Within this framework, we commit specifically to:

- Comply with all applicable regulatory requirements in relation to environmental aspects,
- Seek continuous improvement of environmental management with the aim to reduce the environmental impact of our activities,
- Protect the environment and prevent pollution within the scope of our activities.

To meet these commitments, we undertake the following actions:

- Measure and monitor our environmental performance to have a full understanding of environmental impacts of our operations,
- Identify and implement actions aimed at reducing FIA's environmental impacts, starting from most impactful categories,
- Promote sustainability and environmental awareness and involve internal and external stakeholders in reaching the objectives.

We set specific targets and action plans and allocate necessary resources to deliver the expected outcomes within the framework of this policy. Performance against targets will be assessed annually.

The FIA's environmental policy is communicated to all our employees and stakeholders and is shared publicly on the FIA.com website.
