The following driver will use a new internal combustion engine (ICE) for the remainder of the Event:

| Number | Car | Driver | Previously used ICE |

| 03 | Red Bull Racing Renault | Daniel Ricciardo | 3 |

The internal combustion engine used by the above driver is one of the four new internal combustion engines allowed for the 2015 Championship season and this is in conformity with Article 28.4a of the 2015 Formula One Sporting Regulations.

The following driver will use a new a new turbocharger (TC) for the remainder of the Event:

| Number | Car | Driver | Previously used TC |
|--------|-------------------------|------------------|--------------------|
| 03 | Red Bull Racing Renault | Daniel Ricciardo | 2 |

The turbocharger used by the above driver is one of the four new turbochargers allowed for the 2015 Championship season and this is in conformity with Article 28.4a of the 2015 Formula One Sporting Regulations.

The following driver will use a new motor generator unit-heat (MGU-H) for the remainder of the Event:
