The FIA Environmental Accreditation Programme is aimed at helping motor sport and mobility stakeholders worldwide to measure and enhance their environmental performance. By introducing a clear and consistent environmental management system, it provides stakeholders with a three-level framework against which to accredit their activities. It is organised around three levels:



#### ONE-STAR BASIC PRACTICE

Demonstrates basic environmental performance and a commitment to improve.



#### TWO-STAR GOOD PRACTICE

Demonstrates good environmental performance and is close to following internationally developed roadmaps toward environmental management.



#### THREE-STAR BEST PRACTICE

Demonstrates best practice and commitment to seek continual improvement through the implementation of an environmental management system.

One- and two-star accredited stakeholders are encouraged to progress towards the next level of accreditation.
