## 2016 FIA World Endurance Championship Sporting Regulations

#### Decision

## <u>Clarification art 9.2.4 – Sporting Regulations :</u>

For a day time private session, the track time is counted and must be declared with 9 hours of green light (track open to test) over a period of 12 hours which is considered as 1 day/car.

In order to take into account all situations, especially when other competitors want to join a test already declared, the track time is to be considered as follow:

- For each part of the test day: exact track times (first pit out- last pit in) per car.
- For each day, the time of the longest break (last pit in before the break, first pit out after the break) will be deducted to reflect a lunch break allowance.

Thereby, over the period of 12h, the timekeeping data will reflect the 9h green-time of each team.
