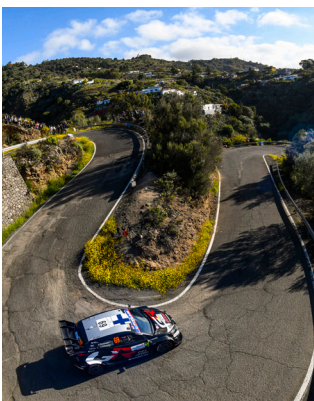

ABU DHABI DESERT CHALLENGE (ADDC)



«Emirates Motorsports Organization's 3-Star FIA Environmental Accreditation, first achieved in 2015, has played a central role in structuring and advancing our sustainability journey. This accreditation provided an internationally recognized framework that enabled us to progress beyond isolated initiatives toward a strategic, measurable, and continuously improving approach to environmental management. It delivered tangible organizational value by strengthening governance, enhancing internal processes, and aligning our operations with global best practices in motorsport sustainability.

The FIA Environmental Accreditation has strengthened stakeholder confidence in EMSO's commitments, clearly demonstrating that sustainability is a core organizational priority embedded at both strategic and operational levels. Building on this, the Abu Dhabi Desert Challenge (ADDC), organized by Emirates Motorsports Organization and supported by the Government of Abu Dhabi and its entities, and our partners, became in 2025 the first FIA Rally-Raid World Championship event to achieve the FIA 2-Star Environmental Accreditation. This milestone reflects the successful implementation of a structured Environmental Management System, aligned with FIA standards.

The event's framework included the development of a dedicated environmental guidelines, environmental impact assessments, and clearly defined waste management and sustainable procurement protocols. Robust legal compliance procedures were implemented to ensure adherence to national and international environmental regulations. Environmental training and awareness sessions were delivered to organizing staff, contractors, service providers, and competing teams, ensuring shared responsibility and consistent implementation of sustainability measures across all operational areas.

The achievement of the 2-Star Accreditation at the ADDC demonstrates how EMSO's long-standing commitment to FIA Environmental Accreditation continues to translate into concrete, measurable outcomes at event level, reinforcing our leadership role in advancing sustainable motorsport within the region and globally.

Looking ahead, EMSO remains fully committed to continuous improvement under the FIA Environmental Accreditation framework. We will continue strengthening our environmental management systems and sharing best practices across all UAE sanctioned motorsport events to ensure that sustainability principles are consistently reflected throughout the national motorsport ecosystem.»

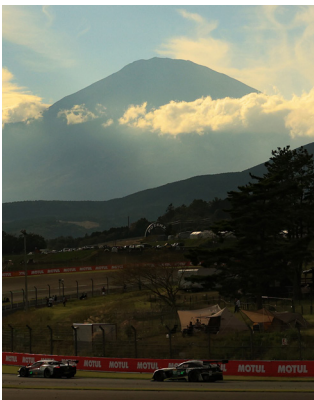
