Request(s):

Relief from the compulsory compensation weight use or exemption to use reduced weight.

"79. Compensation weight always relates to the homologated model from his actual homolgation cycle."

Reason(s):

We request the TC Comitee to allow us not to carry the same weight as the Honda Civic WTCC cars from the new homolgation cycle (300/01 KS) on our H49-008 Honda Civic WTCC car, because our car relates to the last homolgation cycle (200/01 KS). If we should use the same weight as the cars from the new cycle our performance will remain the same as in Morocco or in Monza:

- top speed Morocco Qualifying: Michigami and Panis 190,4, Daniel 187,5
- top speed Monza Qualifying: Tiago 264, Daniel 253
- Average laptime diff/km: +0,5 second

We also a small private team, who does not have the same financial budget to upgrade both of our cars to the new homologation cycle.
