Request(s):

- We officially request to change our Honda CIVIC Type R from TCN2 to TCR V2017. We have ordered the Homologation papers and Upgradekit by JAS/TCR and will bring them to the Nürburgring. All parts are according to the homologation to TCR 2017 except the modifications made to the doors to accept the protection foam as per TCN2 regulations (but to be as close as possible to the TCR regulations we have retro-fitted glass windows on these "TCN2 doors"). Our wish is to keep this protective foam for obvious safety reasons. These "TCN2 doors, fitted with glass windows" have no influence on the performance of the car.
