Fact Alleged failure to stay above the minimum time set by the FIA ECU under the virtual safety car.

Offence Alleged breach of Article 40.5 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

Decision No further action.

Reason The Stewards received a report from the Race Director that Car 30 (Jolyon Palmer) did not stay above the minimum time under the VSC at 11:55 during Free Practice 3. Having examined the telemetry data, the video evidence and having heard from the team, the driver and the FIA software department, the Stewards are satisfied, having examined the full evidence available to the FIA, that the Driver took all appropriate steps to follow the reference lap time, drove at an appropriate speed when he was briefly without a reference and therefore take no further action. The team is instructed to determine with the FIA why the reference was not available for the brief period.
