Note to Teams

As in Spain and Monaco, the same post-qualifying interview procedures will also be used here in Montreal, therefore, the top three drivers will once again be interviewed on the track in front of the fans.

Should either of your drivers be among the top three at the end of qualifying we would like to ask for your co-operation in following the simple procedure set out below:

- At the end of Q3 the top three drivers should drive through the pit lane and stop at the post-race parc fermé located at the pit exit after the race control building.
- Once out of their cars the drivers will be weighed and will then be driven to Turn 2 in the FIA medical car where the live post-qualifying interview session will take place.
- At the end of the interviews the drivers will be brought back to the post-race parc fermé, again using the medical car.
- The drivers will then do the traditional FIA Action for Road Safety photo shoot and should then walk through the paddock to the press conference room and then on to the TV pen.
- You should also be aware that no team PRs or physios will be allowed on track.

I trust this is clear and that it will not cause you or your team any difficulty.
