The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Competitor Renault Sport F1 Team

**Time** 14:03

Session Race

**Fact** Alleged causing a collision by car 27 on car 8.

Offence Involved in an alleged incident as defined by Article 38.1 of the FIA Formula One

Sporting Regulations.

**Decision** No further Action.

**Reason** The Stewards reviewed multiple angles of video, including several in-car and closed

circuit cameras. Hulkenberg and Grosjean were alongside each other under braking and turning in for Turn 1 on Lap 1. Hulkenberg, who was behind the two Force India cars, understeered slightly while avoiding the cars in front, but at the same time Grosjean slightly tightened his line. The Stewards therefore determined that neither

driver was wholly or predominantly to blame for the collision.
