The following driver will use a new internal combustion engine (ICE) for the remainder of the Event:

The internal combustion engine used by Sebastian Vettel is the fifth new internal combustion engine for the 2017 Championship season and as this is not in conformity with Article 23.3a of the 2017 Formula One Sporting Regulations, I am referring this matter to the stewards for their consideration. The team informed the technical delegate about the ICE change on 30th September 2017, at 19:10 hours.

The turbocharger used by Sebastian Vettel is the fifth new turbocharger for the 2017 Championship season and as this is not in conformity with Article 23.3a of the 2017 Formula One Sporting Regulations, I am referring this matter to the stewards for their consideration. The team informed the technical delegate about the TC change on 30th September 2017, at 19:10 hours.

The following driver will use a new motor generator unit-heat (MGU-H) for the remainder of the Event:

05 Ferrari Sebastian Vettel 4

The motor generator unit-heat used by Sebastian Vettel is the fifth new motor generator unit-heat for the 2017 Championship season and as this is not in conformity with Article 23.3a of the 2017 Formula One Sporting Regulations, I am referring this matter to the stewards for their consideration. The team informed the technical delegate about the MGU-H change on 30th September 2017, at 19:10 hours.

All above PU components have been replaced with the approval of the FIA technical delegate following a written request from the team concerned, this being in accordance with Article 34.2 of the 2017 Formula One Sporting Regulations.
