The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 33 - Max Verstappen

Competitor Aston Martin Red Bull Racing

Session Practice 3

Fact Car 33 left the track and did not stay to the left of the bollard when re-joining the track in turn 2.

Offence Alleged breach of Article 12.1.1 i. of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision No further action.

Reason The Race Director's notes specify that "Any driver who fails to negotiate turn 2 by using the track, and who passes over one of the speed bumps across the run-off area, must then re-join the track by driving to the left of the bollard before the entry to turn 3." The driver of car 33 left the track at turn 2 and then did not pass to the left of the bollard. The team noted that the driver weaved between the speed bumps and not over them. As there was no advantage gained in this practice session and the driver re-joined safely, the Stewards chose to take no further action. The event notes will be updated to clarify this point.
