Fact Car 33 was alleged to have left the track and re-joined in an unsafe manner in turn 1.

Offence Alleged breach of Article 27.3 and 27.4 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

Decision No further action.

Reason The Stewards reviewed video evidence and heard from the driver of car 33. Max

Verstappen and found that yellow flags (first a single yellow and later a double yellow) had been waived to warn the other drivers that his car had gone off the track at Turn 1. Car 33 (VER) had to reverse on to the track to rejoin but did so under yellow flags and

in a manner that posed no danger to the other drivers.
