The Stewards, having received a report from the Technical Delegate (document 33), have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 35 - Sergey Sirotkin

**Competitor** Williams Martini Racing

**Time** 11:01

**Session** Qualifying

**Fact** Parts have been changed to those of a different specification whilst the car was under Parc Fermé conditions.

**Offence** Breach of Article 34.6 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

**Decision** Required to start from the Pit Lane.

**Reason** As the parts are of a different specification to those used originally in qualifying the competitor is required to start from the pit lane and should follow the procedures laid out in Article 36.2 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

The team notified the Technical Delegate of the change of parts/aerodynamic specification on Saturday 7th July, at 21:19.

All Competitors are reminded of their right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, as set out in the International Sporting Code and related regulations, including the time limits for such appeals.
