Fact Parts have been changed to those of a different specification and changes have been made to the setup of the suspension whilst the car was under Parc Fermé conditions.

Offence Breach of Article 34.6 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

Decision Required to start from the Pit Lane.

Reason As the parts are of a different specification to those used originally in qualifying and the setup of the suspension has also been changed the competitor is required to start from the pit lane and should follow the procedures laid out in Article 36.2 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal the decisions of the Stewards (with the exception of those referred to in Article 12.2.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code), in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
