The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

<b>No / Driver</b>	35 - Sergey Sirotkin
<b>Competitor</b>	Williams Martini Racing
<b>Time</b>	21:35
<b>Session</b>	Race
<b>Fact</b>	Car 35 forced car 28 off the track in turn 14.
<b>Offence</b>	Breach of Article 27.4 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations read with Appendix L Chapter IV Article 2b of the FIA International Sporting Code.
<b>Decision</b>	5 second time penalty (2 penalty points awarded, 6 points for the 12 month period)
<b>Reason</b>	The Stewards reviewed video evidence and determined that approaching turn 14 car No. 28 was passing car No. 35. Car No. 35 forced car No. 28 off the track so much so that car No. 28 had to come to a near stop to avoid a collision.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal the decisions of the Stewards (with the exception of those referred to in Article 12.2.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code), in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
