The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 33 - Max Verstappen

**Competitor** Aston Martin Red Bull Racing

**Time** 14:15

**Session** Race

**Fact** Car 33 left the track at turn 16 and re-joined unsafely.

**Offence** Breach of Article 27.3 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

**Decision** 5 Second Time Penalty  
(1 penalty points awarded, 8 points for the 12 month period)

**Reason** The Stewards reviewed the video evidence, and determined that car 33 locked up his brakes and left the track at turn 16, cut the chicane and re-joined track on the racing line in turn 17 and in the process collided with car 7.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal the decisions of the Stewards (with the exception of those referred to in Article 12.2.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code), in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
