The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 16 - Charles Leclerc

**Competitor** Alfa Romeo Sauber F1 Team

**Time** 14:15

**Session** Race

**Fact** Car 16 and Car 20 collided in the main straight.

**Offence** Involved in an alleged incident as defined by Article 38.1 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

**Decision** No further action.

**Reason** The Stewards reviewed the video evidence and determined that while there was contact between the drivers, no driver was wholly or predominantly to blame for the incident.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal the decisions of the Stewards (with the exception of those referred to in Article 12.2.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code), in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
