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The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

<b>No / Driver</b>	18 - Lance Stroll
<b>Competitor</b>	Williams Martini Racing
<b>Time</b>	13:14
<b>Session</b>	Race
<b>Fact</b>	Car 18 collided with car 14 in turn 4.
<b>Offence</b>	Involved in an incident as defined by Article 38.1 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.
<b>Decision</b>	Drive through penalty (2 penalty points awarded, 7 points for the 12 month period)
<b>Reason</b>	The Stewards reviewed the video evidence, noting that during the first lap car 18 left the track and while re-joining at turn 4 made contact with car 14. As a result of the incident car 14 retired. The Stewards considered that the driver of car 18 is fully to blame for the incident.  Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal the decisions of the Stewards (with the exception of those referred to in Article 12.2.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code), in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
