The following driver will start the nineteenth Event of the 2018 Formula One World Championship with a new internal combustion engine (ICE):

10	Toro Rosso Honda	Pierre Gasly	7

The internal combustion engine used by Pierre Gasly is the eighth new internal combustion engine for the 2018 Championship season and this is not in conformity with Article 23.3a of the 2018 Formula One Sporting Regulations.
