Technical Delegate's Report

The following drivers will start the nineteenth Event of the 2018 Formula One World Championship with a new gearbox:

| 55 | Renault | Carlos Sainz |

The above drivers used their previous gearbox for six consecutive Events in conformity with Article 23.5a of the 2018 Formula One Sporting Regulations.

| 14 | McLaren Renault | Fernando Alonso |

The above driver did not finish the last race in Austin and is in conformity with Article 23.5a of the 2018 Formula One Sporting Regulations.

| 10 | Toro Rosso Honda | Pierre Gasly |

The above driver did finish the last race in Austin and this gearbox change was before the six consecutive Events expired. Therefore this is not in compliance with Article 23.5a of the 2018 Formula One Sporting Regulations.

|--------|---------------|----------------|
| 33 | RBR TAG Heuer | Max Verstappen |

The above driver had to replace his previous gearbox during the last Event for a spare gearbox and this was before the six consecutive Events expired. Therefore he may use a new gearbox at this Event and the six consecutive Events will start here in accordance with Article 23.5a of the 2018 Formula One Sporting Regulations.
