THE REGION - Janovice nad Úhlavou

The rally is based in the small town of Janovice nad Úhlavou, 8km south west of Klatovy and has a population of approximately 2200 inhabitants.

The first mention of Janovice nad Úhlavou, in Latin texts Janovicium, dates back to 1290, when the important Czech family Janovských of Janovice built a fortress surrounded by a moat and stayed for three centuries. Since the 14th century Janovice nad Úhlavou grew into a small town.

The current Janovice nad Úhlavou has been a small quiet town since 2004, when it was left by the army. As a memorial to the army, the building of the former barracks of about 45 hectares remained. The city decided to take a bold step - it took over the property and decided to try to revive it. After the takeover, the whole building was leased to a developer, whose main task is to ensure the development of the area, now known as the "Janovice nad Úhlavou Development Zone", in cooperation with the town.





THE REGION - Klatovy

The town of Klatovy is situated in Western Bohemia, about 40km South from Plzeň (Pilsen) and has 23,000 inhabitants.

The town was founded in 1260 by Czech king Přemysl Otakar II. to protect the kingdom and merchant way to Bavaria. During the Middle Ages Klatovy developed into one of the most important town in Bohemia. In the 17th century the town grew into regional centre of knowledge thanks to the Jesuits, who arrived in 1636. In the same year they founded secondary school and three years after The Baroque Pharmacy, which is marked as an UNESCO monument. Another important monument concerning the Jesuits is the Catacomb, where the richest citizens are entombed.

In the course of the 19th and 20th century Klatovy developed into an important industrial town. Today Klatovy is the seat of the Municipality.

RALLY FACTS

- All Special Stages are in district Klatovy and district Strakonice (Jihočeský kraj)
- Special Stage 1 in Klatovy is 50 years old this year
- Some Special Stages are on the border with Šumava Europe's largest forest
- The rally HQ only moved to Janovice nad Uhlavou a few years ago. Before that the rally was based in Klatovy. However the start and the rally finish is still held in Míru Square in Klatovy
