| Facts | Cars 8 and 28 crossed the white line at the Pit Entry. |
| Offence | Alleged breach of Chapter IV, Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code Article 4 d) and Race Director Notes 6.2. |
| Decision | The Stewards consider this a case of <i>force majeure</i> and hence no further action is warranted. |
| Reason | Race Director Notes 6.2 states that “for reasons of safety” drivers must stay to the left of the white line however in this case, to continue on another lap would have been unsafe as both cars required pit attention. Article 4 d) of Chapter IV Appendix L specifically allows for crossing of the line in the case of <i>force majeure</i> . |

All parties are reminded of their right of appeal under Article 14 of the International Sporting Code.
