The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, heard from the drivers and team representative and examined video evidence, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

No / Driver 20 - Kevin Magnussen

Competitor Renault Sport F1 Team

Session Race

Fact Causing a collision with car 30 in turn 13.

Offence Involved in an incident as defined by Article 38.1 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations

Decision 10 Second Time Penalty imposed after the race in accordance with Article 38.3 (10 seconds added to elapsed race time).
(2 penalty points awarded, 2 points in total for the 12 month period)

Reason Car 20 was on a new set of soft tyres, and Car 30 was on an older set of hard tyres leading the driver of Car 20 to have significantly better grip and speed. However, the Stewards determined that Car 20 could not have reasonably expected to make the corner of Turn 13 without colliding with Car 30, which was subsequently forced off the track. The Stewards imposed the penalty referred to, which was converted to a time penalty after the race as the cars were on the last lap.
