2016 FIA World Endurance Championship Sporting Regulations

Decision

According to the Sporting Regulations Article 4.3, each competitor entered in the Manufacturers World Endurance Championship may not have more than 65 operational people for each 6-hours WEC race after Le Mans 2016.

Hereafter the process flow for each 6-hours WEC race:

- During **initial scrutineering of its cars**, each Team Manager will submit to the FIA/ACO inspector the operational staff list using the standard reporting form duly completed.
- Consequently, the FIA/ACO inspector will deliver to each Team Manager 65 coloured bracelets
- These coloured bracelets will have to be worn by the operational people from the start of the first practice session until the end of the race
