<u>Update of Appendix L Chapter I "FIA International Drivers' Licences" – Article 4</u> <u>"Qualification for Grades A and B"</u>

Dear Sir or Madam,

We would like to inform you that the qualification requirements for the Grade A licence regulations were updated following the World Motor Sport Council held in September in Paris, and can be found on the FIA website at the following link: www.fia.com.

In addition to the previous requirements, the new regulations allow a driver who has finished in the first 5 places in the general classification of 5 races of the FIA F3 European Championship within the 24 months prior to the Grade A application to be eligible for a Grade A licence.
