Decision

Please find below a clarification regarding the allocation of car/days of private testing regulation (clarification in red) in reference to Article 9.2.4 – Sporting Regulations :

9.2.4 Number of test days:

a) Car/days limitation

Any limitation of the amount of testing is counted as car/days. The amount that will be taken into account is the number of cars testing for each test day. For example, 2 cars testing on the same day will be counted as 2 car/days.

b) (Not applicable to LMP1 competitors) Any open private testing declared beforehand respecting the pre-announcement period may be postponed or cancelled only in case of force majeure and provided that no other competitor wants to join the test. A request for postponement or cancellation can then be made to the Endurance Committee providing associated evidence.
