10.8.4. Operations and people allowed during a pit stop

.....

- 4 mechanics, wearing mandatory green armbands supplied by the organizer:
 - Allowed in the working area only after the car has stopped in front of his garage
 - During refueling, allowed to :
 - Clean windscreen, mirrors, lights, race numbers, camera; **removal of obstructions in air intakes and radiators;**
 - **Removal of obstructions in air intakes (for cooling purpose only) and radiators, no tools allowed;**
 - Ground the car;
 - Any operation inside the cockpit including driver help (no tools allowed)
 - Change/repair of Fuel Flow Meter. If a Fuel Flow Meter change/repair is required, the operator is allowed in the working area before the car arrives and stops in front of his garage and until the car leaves the area. In that case the Fuel Flow Meter change must be done prior to any other operation.
 - When refueling and vent hoses are not connected to the car and/or, if applicable, once the repairs, and/or the replacement of the fuel flow meter have been completed, the following operations are allowed:
 - any intervention on the car (for tyre change the provisions of Article 10.8.3 must be strictly adhered to);
 - pushing the car in accordance with the provisions of Article 10.8 of these regulations.
