From Downtown Austin to the Media Accreditation Center:

Follow I-35 S/US-290 W and TX-71 E to Garfield. Exit and turn right down Kellam Road. The Media Accreditation Center will be on your left.

From MAC to Lot A:

Once you have received your credentials and parking pass, please follow the "MEDIA PARKING" directional signage down COTA Boulevard to Parking Lot A.

If you already have your parking pass:

Circuit of The Americas is located 15 miles south east of downtown Austin and connected to the downtown area via TX-71, US-183 and the 45/130 toll road. From downtown Austin, take I-35 South to TX-71 East. Exit TX-71 at Burleson Road and continue until Highway 183. Go south on Highway 183 and make a left on FM 812. After passing underneath the 45/130 toll road, Circuit of The Americas will be on your left.

Distance from Austin Airport:

Distance to Circuit of The Americas from Austin-Bergstrom International Airport is 10 miles. Travel TX71 or 45/130 Toll Road.



The premier destination for world-class motorsports and entertainment in the United States. Set on 1,500 acres in the rolling hills just outside downtown Austin, Circuit of The Americas has hosted the biggest names in racing, action sports and music since 2012. At its heart is a 3.41-mile racetrack that was designed to challenge the world's most exacting competitors while providing a thrilling spectacle for audiences.

The 20-turn, counterclockwise circuit takes advantage of the naturally undulating landscape, including an intimidating 133-foot hill at Turn 1 that you have to see in person to believe. Hockenheim dates all the way back to 1932, when it was created by Mercedes as a test track for their cars, in particular to fettle them for the Tripoli Grand Prix. The original track was an enormous 12km triangular affair – in fact it was called the 'Dreieckskurs', or 'Triangle Track' – that speared off to the outskirts of nearby Otfersheim before looping back via the current B291.

Launched in 2014, FIA Formula 4 was created to offer young race car drivers around the world the opportunity to take the first step from karting into the world of open-wheel racing.

Designed to be globally recognized yet an affordable step between karting and F3, the F4 car was designed to keep costs down while providing an ideal learning tool for young drivers who have never raced cars before.
