The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 35 - Sergey Sirotkin

Competitor Williams Martini Racing

Session Race

Fact Car 35 drove unnecessarily slowly behind the safety car.

Offence Breach of Article 39.5 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

Decision 5 second time penalty
(2 penalty points awarded, 5 points in total for the 12 month period)

Reason The Stewards reviewed video, team radio communications and GPS data. Car 35 was instructed to stack behind Car 18 and to go "plus 8". The driver of Car 35 then slowed significantly creating a large gap behind Car 18, by driving unnecessarily slowly.
All Competitors are hereby reminded of their right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, as set out in the International Sporting Code and related regulations, including the time limits for such appeals.
