EPIC LEWIS LEAVES SINGAPORE BREATHLESS

The Killers were about to go on stage but it was Lewis Hamilton who murdered the opposition when he put his Mercedes on pole for Sunday's Formula 1 2018 Singapore Airlines Singapore Grand Prix.

On perhaps the most spectacular stage in the F1 world. Hamilton produced a stunning lap of 1:36.015 to claim his fourth Singapore pole, his seventh in 2018 and the 79th of his Formula 1 career.

'That lap felt like magic,' said Hamilton, 'in fact I don't even know where it came from! I am superoverwhelmed, my heart's racing. It was one of the best laps that I remember feeling.'

For the second year running in Singapore Max Verstappen shared the front row after overcoming persistent engine niggles to put his Red Bull alongside Hamilton's Mercedes. 'This feels like a victory after the amount of problems we've had today,' said the Dutchman. 'To be second is unbelievable and shows we have an amazing car.'

Hamilton's fourth Singapore pole matched the record of Sebastian Vettel, who was third for Ferrari. 'Not ideal,' shrugged the four-time Marina Bay winner. 'It was a bit of a messy qualifying for us and at the end there was too much time missing.'

Vettel was joined on the second row by Valtteri Bottas in the second Mercedes, while Vettel's teammate Kimi Räikkönen, who had a spin midway through the second segment of qualifying, finished fifth with the Red Bull of Daniel Ricciardo alongside him - the first time in his Red Bull career that the Australian did not start from the front three in Singapore.

It was a good session for the newly renamed Racing Point Force India with Sergio Perez sixth and Esteban Ocon eighth. Between them was the Haas of Romain Grosjean, with Nico Hülkenberg's Renault rounding out the top ten.

Former Singapore winner Fernando Alonso could not get his McLaren higher than 11th, replying with a sarcastic 'Nice' when told that news by his team, while Renault's Carlos Sainz complained that he had 'absolutely no grip' and was 12th.

The two Saubers of Charles Leclerc – who hit the wall a glancing blow at Turn 21 – and Marcus Ericsson were 13th and 14th and Pierre Gasly in the Toro Rosso also failed to make it into Q1.

For the eighth time in 2018 both Williams cars failed to progress from Q1, with Lance Stroll 20th and Sergev Sirotkin 19th, while McLaren's Stoffel Vandoorne also failed to go through for the eighth race in a row after what he called 'a messy lap'.

They were joined by Brendon Hartley, struggling to retain his Toro Rosso seat, and Haas's Kevin Magnussen, who was stuck in Q1 for the first time since the Monaco Grand Prix. 'We need to have the pace.' said the disgruntled Dane, 'so we need to try and understand more for tomorrow. It looks like a tough day but we can only do what we can.'

The last word, though, went to Hamilton. As his pole lap finished his engineer radioed him to say it was 'a pretty epic lap'. Minutes later an elated Hamilton said simply, 'This track is epic.'

FOURTH SINGAPORE WIN PUTS HAMILTON STREETS AHEAD IN TITLE RACE

Lewis Hamilton's fifth World Championship came a whole lot closer when the Mercedes driver and his Mercedes team outsmarted Ferrari to claim victory on Singapore's Marina Bay Circuit in 2018.

Starting from pole, Hamilton raced into the early lead, produced a series of super-quick laps to keep Sebastian Vettel's Ferrari at bay at pit stop time, then responded to everything Max Verstappen's Red Bull could throw at him in the closing stages to claim his fourth victory on the Singapore streets.

'Great job everyone!' yelled Hamilton on his radio as he finished the 61-lap race almost nine seconds clear of Verstappen. 'We've got these guys!' That meant Ferrari, for whom Vettel could finish no higher than third to fall 40 points behind the Englishman in the title race with six races to go.

Tyre strategies were the key to the race as Ferrari gambled on bringing Vettel in after 14 laps and putting him on to Pirelli's medium compound, the Ultrasoft, only for Mercedes to respond by calling Hamilton in next time around and putting him on to the yellow Softs, the hardest available.

Within a handful of laps Vettel was on the radio saying, 'There is no chance, we are again too late. The tyres will not make it to the end.' They did, but not at the pace Ferrari required, as the German acknowledged: 'Overall we were not quick enough,' he said, 'we didn't have pace in the race. We tried to be aggressive in the beginning and it didn't work out.'

Vettel's woes were underlined by a fine performance from Verstappen, who refused to yield to the German as he brought his Red Bull out after his pit stop and claimed second place as the two went side-by-side through the first two corners.

'Yes!' screamed Verstappen, who was then told to focus and did so well enough to keep that place and secure his first Singapore podium ahead of the disconsolate Vettel. And it might have been more: Verstappen tried valiantly to force his way past Hamilton as the two men closed in on a mid-race squabble between Sergey Sirotkin's Williams and the chasing Haas of Romain Grosjean.

Hamilton held firm, saying 'These guys are crazy,' while Verstappen used more vulgar language to vent his own frustration – and Grosjean was given a five-second penalty for ignoring blue flags telling the slower cars to clear the way.

Valtteri Bottas claimed fourth for Mercedes ahead of Kimi Räikkönen in the other Ferrari, with Daniel Ricciardo's run of four straight Singapore podiums coming to an end when the Australian could bring his Red Bull home only sixth.

The race's major incident happened on the opening lap when Esteban Ocon tried to move round the outside of Racing Point teammate Sergio Perez but was edged into the wall and instantly out of the race – a move which left Ocon seething but brought no action from the race stewards.

Perez was involved once more when he caught Sirotkin's Williams, complained about the Russian's blocking over the radio, then forced his way past only to cut across Sirotkin's bows and cause contact – a rash moment which this time earned him a drive-through penalty.

Sirotkin then blotted his own copybook, earning a drive-through penalty of his own when he pushed the Toro Rosso of Brendon Hartley wide as they both braked into a corner.

On a night when Hamilton's existing lap record was obliterated time and again, it was Haas's Kevin Magnussen who finally set the fastest lap of 1:41.905, an average speed of 178.860 km/h, on lap 50 - and yet the Dane was only 18^{th} of the 19 classified finishers.

Hamilton's seventh victory of 2018 was the 69th of his F1 career and put him on 281 points to Vettel's 241. 'It felt like the longest race of my life,' he said, 'I'm glad it's over.' Perhaps the bigger race – for his fifth world title – was too.
